
What began in 1948 as an organization to help develop "friendly relations" between member countries is now a **global association** with activities in 110 different countries and territories.



Problems identified

>Being short - term projects we do not have tools on project management adjusted from corporate area

Ack of coaching for the project managers during their leading experience

We don't have know-how on implementing projects based on grants received







Problems identified

Ack of preparation of project management processes (tracking and re-planning)

>No internal culture of PM – few specialized people in this area

Project managers do not have proper preparation before leading the project.
