Is an educational and participatory platform for workers awareness on the importance of protecting the natural environment. The project aims at providing information about sustainable consumption practices and about the importance of reuse and selective collection of wastes for recycling.

It was launched in January 2007 by AIESEC Iasi, TERIS and Associations and Foundations of social services Bethany. The Third Edition (since 2009) program is organized by the Association Mai Bine and our Association. In the edition of 2010 was held a session to plant 5,000 seedlings of locust in Voinești, and of the onset of the project have collected 40 tons of paper.
